ACT POLICING NEWS: Outsmart the offender

A new property crime prevention campaign, **Outsmart the Offender**, is being rolled out over the next six months, with the first instalment focussing on car theft. *Lock and hide to protect your ride* will be followed by separate campaigns on home burglary, apartment theft, small business theft and tradie tool theft. We know from feedback from readers that car theft continues to be a problem in our area. Please keep an eye out for unusual or suspicious behaviour.

The campaign encourages the community to remember to:

- Never leave your car keys in obvious places
- Don't leave a car running unless you're in it
- Close all windows and lock all doors
- Don't leave valuables in your car
